To the City Council of the City of San Diego:

I _____, certify that I am at least 18 years of age and live in, or am the appointed representative of a business or property owner or charitable organization, within the selected boundaries for the Downtown Community Planning Council.

I certify that, within the selected boundaries of the Downtown Community Plan Area, I am a:

- Resident** living at (and have included the following documentation):

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- A. California driver's license or picture identification card **AND**
 - B. Utility (other than water) bill, lease or rental agreement or receipt, Housing Commission or rental assistance contract, written letter from landlord verifying occupancy, Deed of Trust or Property, property tax bill, sales contract, mortgage payment contract or book, or current County Tax Assessor property owner listing.

- Business** located at :

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- A. California driver's license or picture identification card **AND**
 - B. Business license (not a professional license), certificate of incorporation, articles of incorporation, deed of trust, property tax bill, current County Tax Assessor listing or property owner listing. If you are not the primary business owner, you must also provide a letter from a Company Officer indicating the company's sponsorship of your candidacy.

- Representative of a community organization** (*A Community Organization means any nonprofit association of persons and/or entities that has its headquarters, a satellite office or a substantial number of constituents/service-recipients within the Downtown Community Plan Area boundaries.*)

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- A. California driver's license or picture identification card **AND**
 - B. Proof of organization's existence and operation within Downtown Community Plan Area boundaries, such as articles of incorporation, by-laws, nonprofit status, or business license **AND**
 - C. Resolution or minutes of the organization legislative or executive body, designating you as its representative to DCPC.
